We could not have a more knowledgeable expert to discuss the early presidential primary outcomes than Professor Jack Citrin, the author of *Nominating the President: Evolution and Revolution in 2008 and Beyond*. Professor Citrin's many other books and edited volumes include *American Identity and the Politics of Multiculturalism*, *Public Opinion and Constitutional Controversy*, and *After the Tax Revolt: Proposition 13 Turns 30*.

Professor Citrin teaches in the field of political behavior, and his research interests include political trust, the foundations of policy preferences, direct democracy, national identity, and ethnic politics, including immigration and language politics.

Professor Citrin received his B.A. and M.A. from McGill University and his Ph.D. from UC Berkeley. He has taught at Berkeley since 1970. Currently serving as Director of the Institute of Governmental Studies, he has been the Director of the State Data Archive and Acting Director of the Survey Research Center.
