Francesco Borrelli is Professor of Mechanical Engineering, Howard Penn Brown Endowed Chair in Mechanical Engineering at UC Berkeley. His research expertise and interests include automotive control systems, distributed and robust constrained control, manufacturing control systems, energy efficient buildings, model predictive control.



Professor Borrelli's research lab focuses on the theoretical and real-time implementation aspects of constrained predictive model-based control. We deal with linear, nonlinear and hybrid systems in both small scale and complex large scale applications.

Art Show for March: Allan Jensen

Allan Jensen has been a member of the Faculty Club since the late 1970's as well as a member of the Faculty Club Monks Chorus since 1987. His art transcends singing and this exhibit focuses on Mr. Jensen's avocation as a photographer.

Mr. Jensen's photographs include samples of nature and wildlife images currently featured on a permanent album at the Baytrail.org Facebook pages entitled "Wildlife on the Richmond Bay Trail". This is his third exhibit at the faculty club and features a series of unique photos of the rare and endangered/protected California

Clapper Rail: His beautiful and unique avian, flora, and landscape photos, now include spectacular sun-rise and sunset images, all of which have been featured in local and regional publications for many years. His work highlights the variety of what nature provides by way of simple walks around parks or preserves here in the bay area.
