Message from the Manager

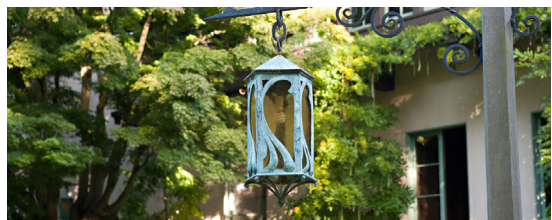
Dear Members,
