## Art Show for August – Pat Hayashi

Self Introduction

I took up art fourteen years ago, when I was fifty-six, because I wanted to have something to do when I retired from a long and satisfying career at UC. I knew mastery was not possible, so I made exploration my goal. Therefore, rather than focus narrowly, I have ranged far and wide and tried my hand at as many genres and mediums as possible. I favor breadth over depth.

Art has taken me to unexpected places. Last October, my wife, Sandy, and I traveled to Kyrgyzstan where, under the aegis of the U.S. State Department's Art in the Embassies program, I gave lectures on art that was created in the Japanese American concentration camps. I also gave master classes in art colleges on how to paint with smoke, a technique I discovered while trying to burn a failed print. The Kyrgyz students had all been taught by Russian-trained art professors and, thus, had a solid grounding in accurate but expressive academic drawing and in the light, color and brushwork of the French Impressionists. The students were all very skilled and enthusiastic. They listened politely to my meticulously prepared lectures and demonstrations on how to paint with the smoke from a wooden match and then ignored everything I said and created beautiful still-lives, landscapes and self-portraits.

I turned seventy this year. It gives me great pleasure to be able to mark this milestone by sharing my work with my many friends and colleagues at Berkeley. Most of the pieces are new, but some I have shown before. I selected these works because they make me happy. I very much appreciate Felix Solomon's kindness in giving me the opportunity to show my paintings and prints in the Faculty Club.

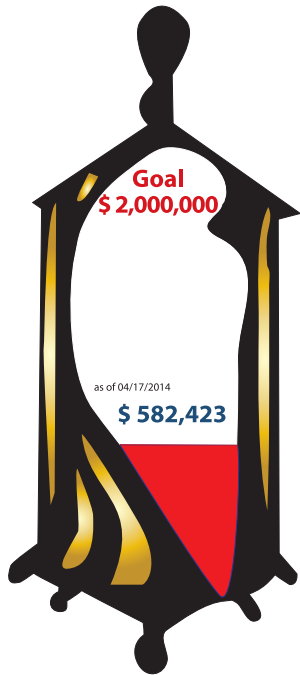
