A Lecture with Professor Geoff Marcy

Dr. Marcy is a Professor of Astronomy at UC Berkeley and Director of Berkeley's "Center for Integrative Planetary Science", a research unit designed to study the formation, geophysics, chemistry and evolution of planets. Dr. Marcy is a leading astrophysicist in the detection and characterization of exoplanets. He and collaborators have discovered over 250 extrasolar planets, allowing ongoing study of their masses, radii, and orbits, including eccentricities and misalignments. His research team discovered the first multiple planet system (Upsilon Andromedae), the first saturn-sized planet, and the first Neptune-size planet. He is a co-investigator with the NASA Kepler mission that recently announced 1230 exoplanets, most being smaller than twice the size of Earth. His current research focuses on finding other Earth-size planets and solar systems similar to our own. Ongoing work is designed to study the sizes, occurrence frequency, chemical composition, and the orbits of Earth-size planets.
