Today his daughter, Dr. Laura Catena Zapata, continues the tradition, producing Catena malbecs, cabernet sauvignons and chardonnays of exceptional quality. She is also a part-time emergency room physician at UCSF and the author of *Vino Argentino: an Insider's Guide to Wines and Wine Country of Argentina*, and will be our host at the dinner, now being planned to show off the wines from Bodega Catena Zapata (see more at www.catenawines.com).
